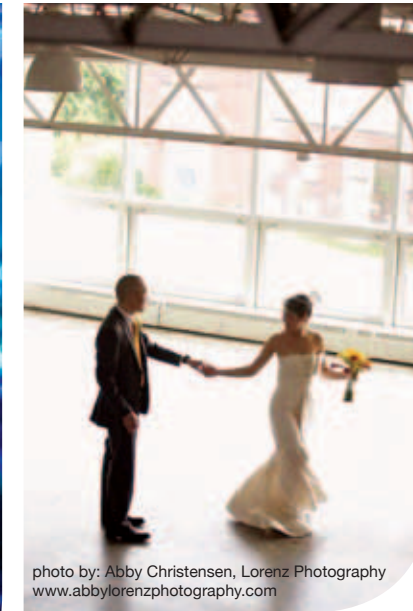

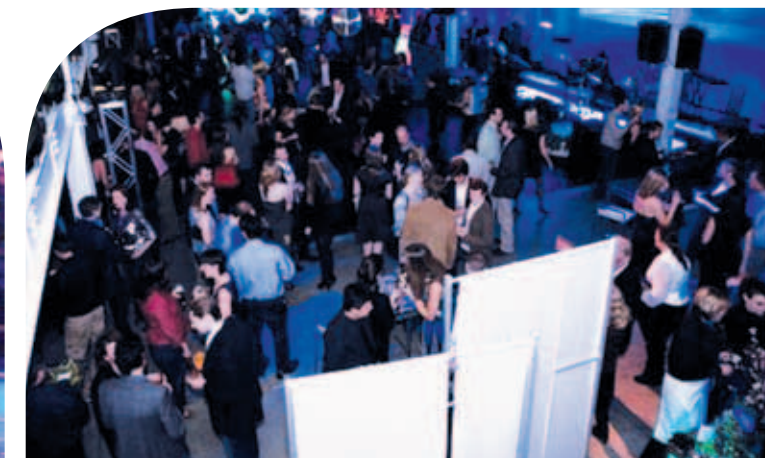

The **Artists for Humanity EpiCenter**, designed by James Batchelor and Patricia L. Cornelison of Arrowstreet Architects, is the first Platinum LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) certified building in Boston. Our eco-friendly EpiCenter generates electricity from our roof's photovoltaic array, and our innovative summer ventilation system cools the Gallery without resorting to AC. Even our building's aesthetics are earth-friendly: our landscaped "courtyard" is made from recycled plastic bottles, and our bathroom stall dividers were formed out of re-furbished plastics.

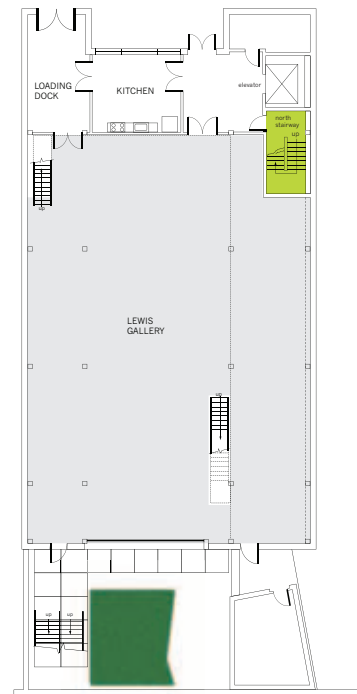

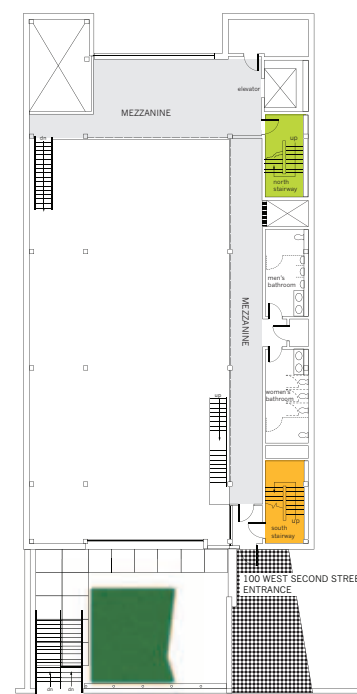

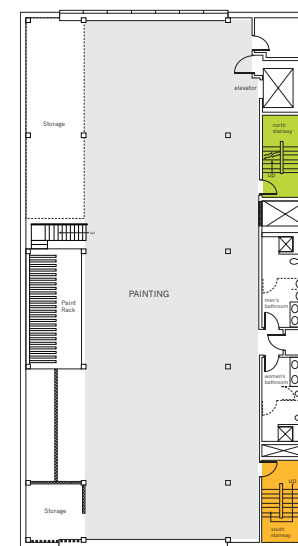
